Objectives of the catch up funding.

- To narrow / close the gap by providing intensive literacy and numeracy support and raise the attainment of those students entitled to Catch- up Premium
- To enhance existing provision.
- To identify concerns and target intervention and support to accelerate progress
- To intervene quickly if any chosen strategy or intervention fails to show impact

- Maths 1-1 and small group tutoring breakfast club and homework club
- Toe to Toe/Lexia/ Reading schemes to improve reading ability between testing
- Paired reading scheme
- Peer mentoring scheme – training and allocation to year 7 form
- Y7 Curriculum for Maths with stress on maths in everyday life
