Safeguarding

Fire Procedures

If you discover a fire, take action by alerting a member of staff or activating the fire alarm. In the unlikely event that the fire alarm should ring during your visit to school, please leave by the nearest available exit. Do not enter any part of the school building until the 'all clear' is given. Muster station for visitors during the school day at the main school entrance. A member of staff will check your presence.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE SCHOOL SITE UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN CHECKED OFF THE REGISTER.

Invacuation

In the event of an invacuation (lockdown for safety due to an emergency situation), visitors and contractors should proceed to the nearest office or supervised classroom as quickly as possible, lock the door behind them using the thumb turn and close any windows and blinds. Visitors are politely requested to refrain from using any mobile or internet device during an invacuation until the all clear is given.

CCTV

Images are being recorded for the purposes of the safety of our students, members of staff and visitors.

First Aid

This building is equipped with first aid facilities. A Defib and qualified first aiders are available. Should an emergency occur, please inform a member of staff or dial 0 for Reception on the nearest telephone and state the nature of the emergency, your location and your name. A first aider will attend as soon as possible.
