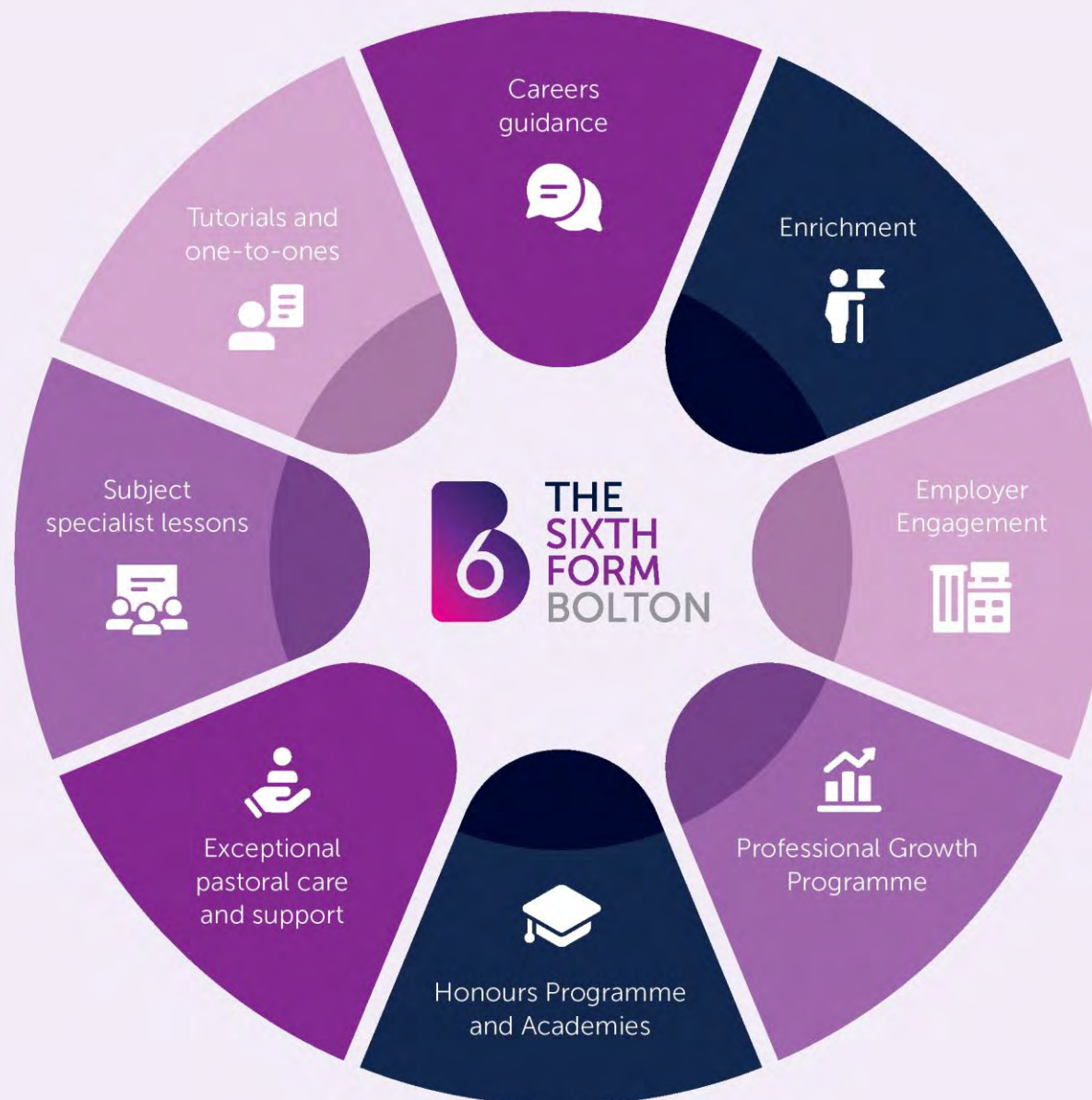

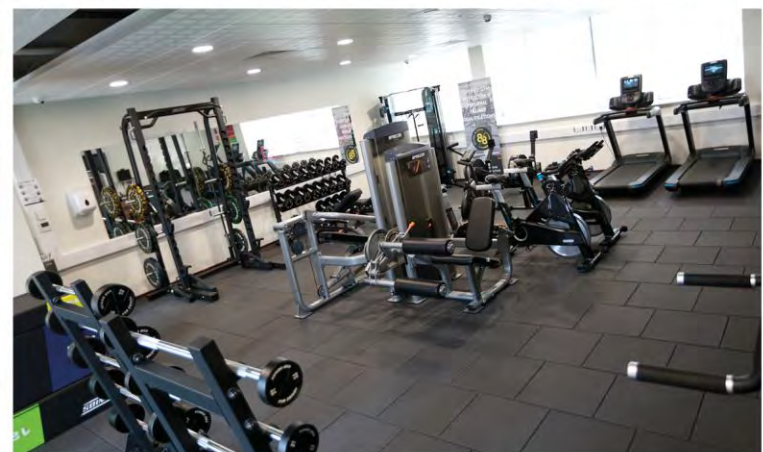

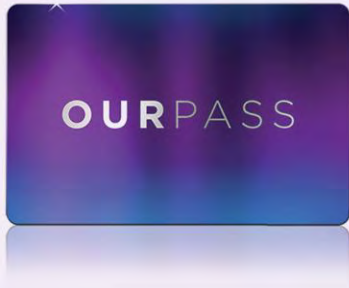

Approximate journey time: 25 minutes

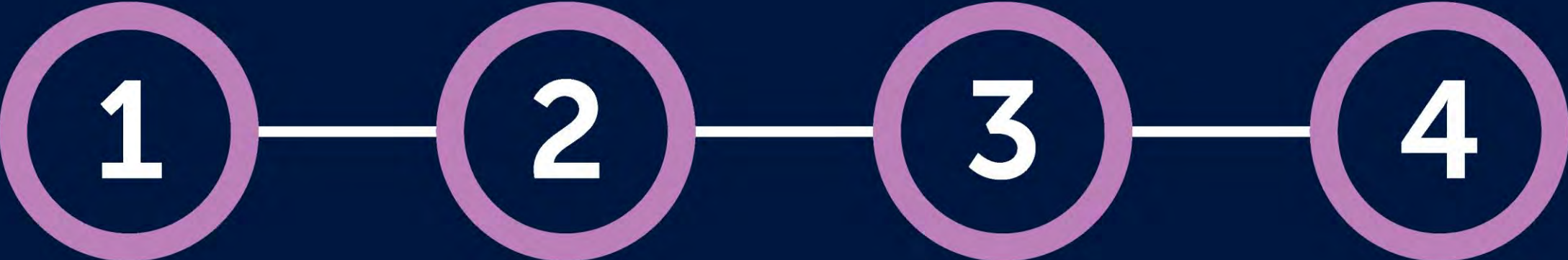
